## *Harley's Story*

### *Help Harley Get a Leg Up!*

Meet Harley, a 14-week-old kitten who lost her leg, but not her love for life. This little kitten is a survivor! She was brought to MEOW Inc after being injured in an area where we are actively engaged in TNR. We rushed her to the emergency vet, where X-rays showed that Harley's humerus was badly damaged. The veterinarian said amputation would give her the best chance for survival, so Harley underwent emergency surgery and is now in recovery.



Because MEOW Inc prioritizes the needs of cats like Harley who have nowhere else to turn, we are now raising funds to pay her \$3,200 bill. MEOW Inc was asked to help when they discovered that neighbors were throwing rocks at the kittens and their very young brown tabby mother who was not much bigger than they were.



So our volunteer trapper managed to catch all of the cats, including pretty Nola. We instantly put Nola and her brother, Oliver, into foster care to see if they could be socialized enough for adoption. While Nola's brother came around slowly, Nola was moving at a snail's pace, not trusting that human hands can be kind and gentle.

Eventually, Oliver was adopted with a young special-needs cat by a great family, but Nola still lacked the socialization skills to connect with adopters. So we moved her to a new foster home with the hope that she could learn to trust new people other than her original foster family.

With that move, Nola decided to take up residence underneath a futon in her new room and refused to come out! But that didn't deter our caring and determined foster. She allowed Nola to move at her own slow pace to feel comfortable and confident in her new surroundings. She laid on the floor near her day after day after day, playing with her dangling toys and leaving her treats as she tried to befriend her and prove that she could be trusted. And eventually, her patience paid off and Nola began to emerge from her shell. She surfaced from hiding and perched herself atop the tall cat condo in the room. She felt safe there, but still wouldn't allow petting.

Weeks went by... six to be exact, before our foster was able to earn her trust and pet her. Nola was then introduced to her foster mom's resident calico and then Nola had two friends! With her social circle growing, so did her confidence, and in time her foster mom was able to gently kiss her head while petting her.

Despite all her progress, we were unable to find someone who was willing to give this little girl a chance that she so desperately needed to find her place in the world. So her foster mom continued to search and hope that the right person would come along. And after over a year of age, Nola finally met her person, who happened to be a friend of her foster mom's who saw the many social media posts about her over time.

Her adopter understood Nola's challenges and endearing quirks and decided that she was precisely the kind of cat she wanted to give a chance at forever. And just like that, she was scooped up into her new life where she hit the jackpot! She now has a Chihuahua brother named Kevin and is the official queen of her own castle with a very kind, understanding and loving human mom who looks after her and loves her dearly. There wasn't a dry eye in the house when everyone heard the news and saw what a perfect home this was for Nola.

Today, her new mom reports that Nola loves to snuggle in bed with her and even touches her shoulder with her paw when she wants affection. We couldn't be happier for her!

We have several beautiful 5-month-old kittens who have been waiting for their forever homes for a long time now!

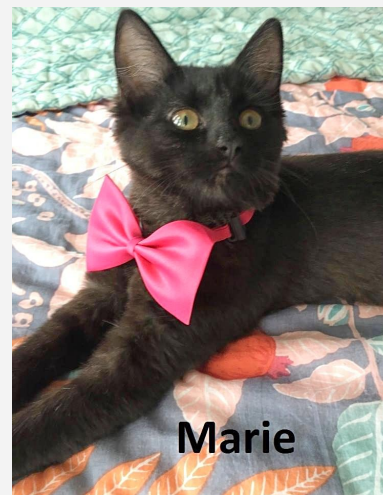

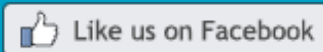
